

Spring has sprung — and with it, here are some thoughts on being a good neighbor:

- ** Weeds grow fast and become an eyesore start now to keep your property clean and neat. Please note that the area between the sidewalk and the road is your responsibility even if there is a wall between your property and the road.
- ** We all need to be sensitive to the amount of noise generated by children playing in the yard and on the streets. High levels of noise are against the ordinances any time of the day, but especially after 10 PM. This includes anything from dogs continuously barking, to people yelling, to loud radios, to motorized vehicles racing up and down the streets. Call 242-COPS if you feel there is any problem, and please also contact the SRMNA Board, so we can document concerns.
- "Please "Scoop the Poop" and dispose of it properly when walking your family pets.
- ** Speaking of pets. please bring them indoors whenever they bark continuously especially at night!

- Mail your \$12.00 annual dues if you have not already done so. If you are new to SRMNA please complete the form below and attach with your annual dues;
- Remove weeds from your front yard, side yard and in the graveled curbed areas in front, side or rear of your property. Because of budgetary constraints, SRMNA Weed & Litter Committee can no longer send multiple notices to repeat violators. If you are a repeat violator referrals will be sent to Zoning and/or 311;
- Avoid parking vehicles in the prohibited portion of your front yard;
- Scoop the poop and dispose of properly when walking your family pets;
- Report any suspicious persons and/or vehicles in your area by calling 242-COPS. Keep windows/doors in your home/vehicles properly secured and avoid leaving valuables in your vehicle. If you feel it's an emergency call 911;
- a Bring in your trash containers before dark on trash day;
- Make arrangements to park recreational vehicles (<u>Camping Trailers & Boats</u>) elsewhere. Some covenants and City Zoning Ordinances do not allow them to be parked in your driveways for an extended period of time;
- Report Trail Complaints to 311 or email us for a resolution.
